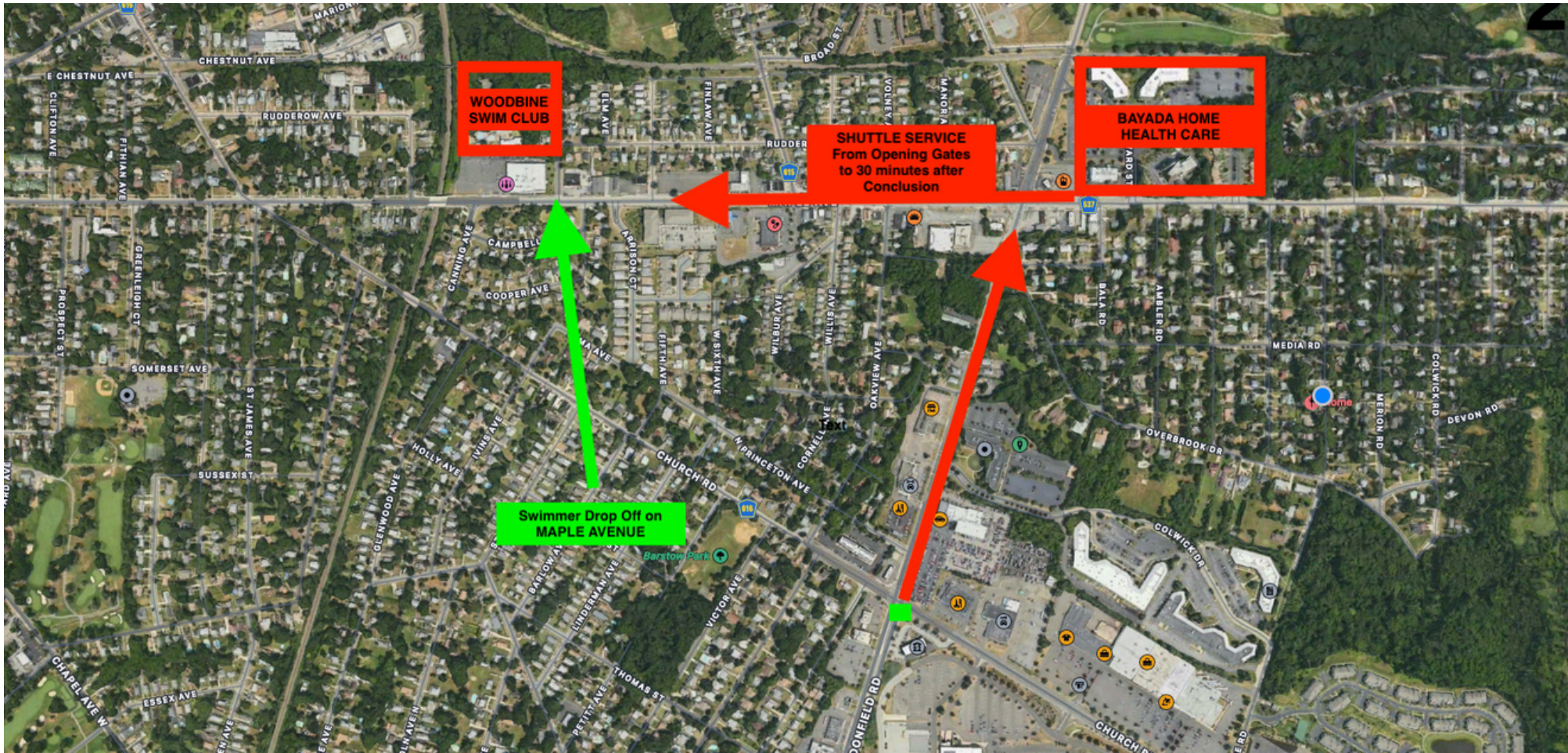

Parking Instructions

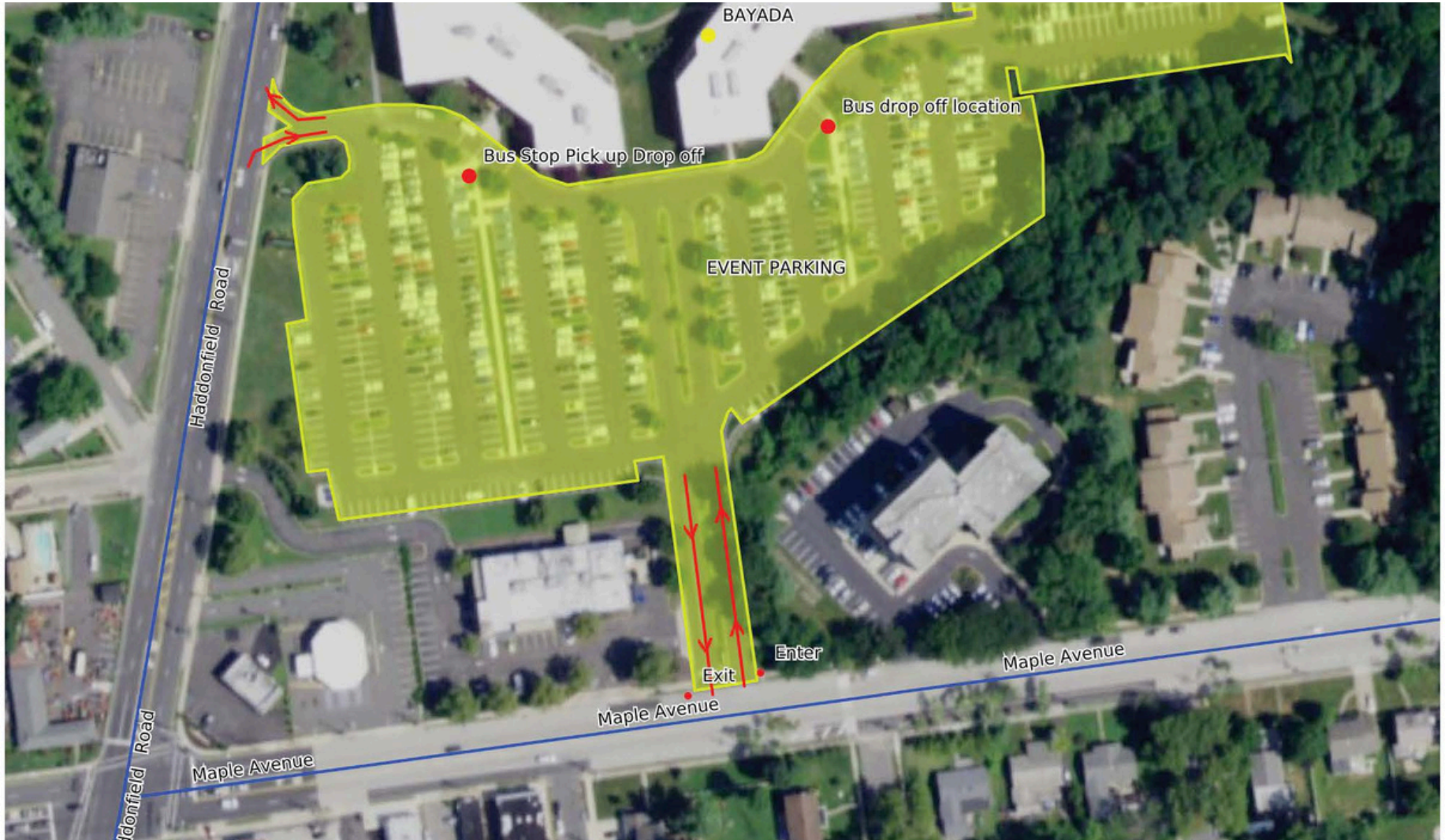
There will be a swimmer drop off line on Maple Avenue from the 7400 block of Maple Avenue to 7111 Maple Avenue (Pinsetters Bowling). This drop off will be set up like cattle shoot. It will be set up for the safety of all the swimmers while being dropped off. Drop off will be on one side of the Maple Avenue

Anyone coming from the Merchantville area will have to pass the Woodbine Swim Club and use the designated U-turn around to enter the drop off area

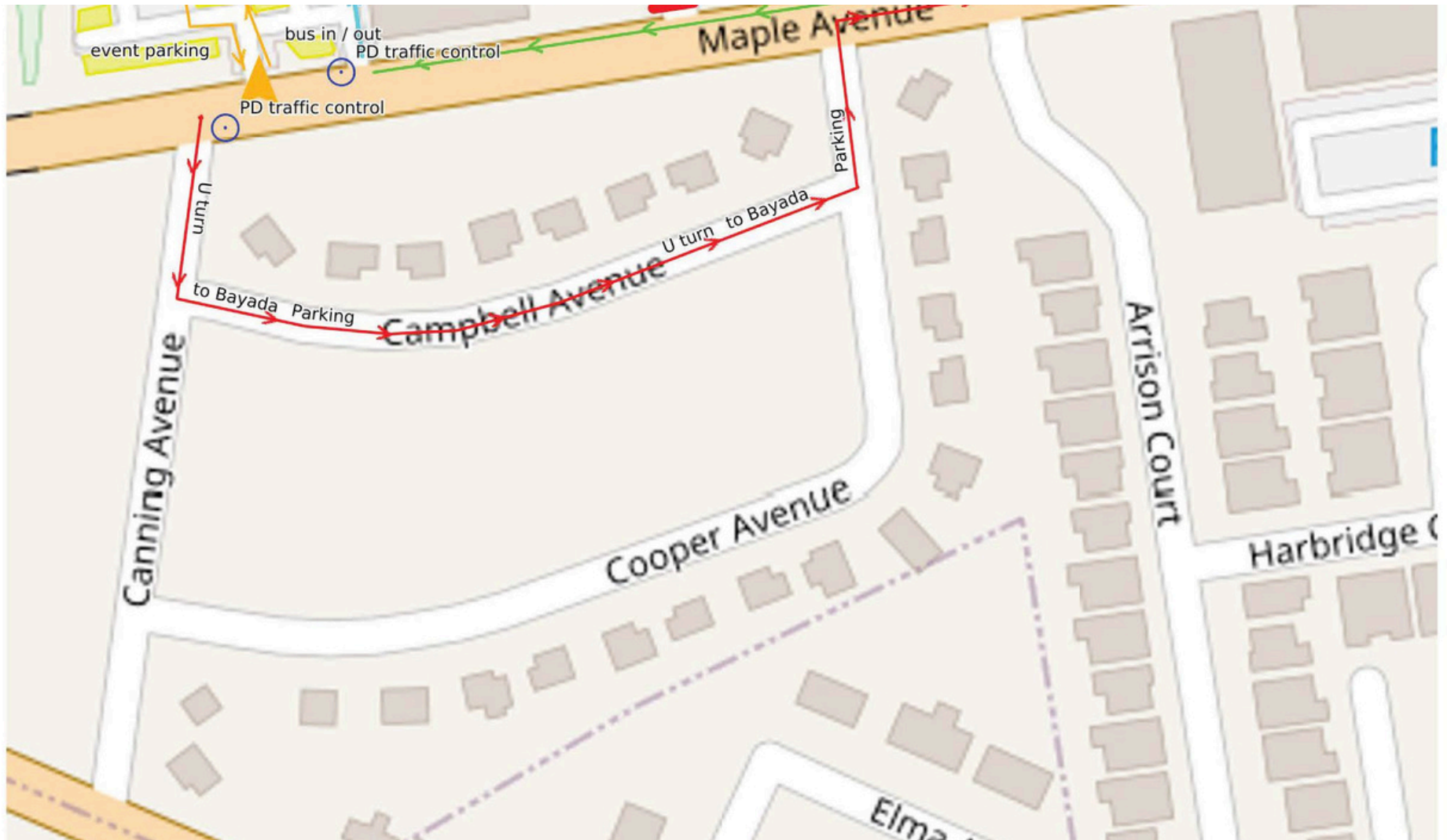
Once the swimmer is dropped off, drivers may continue westbound on Maple Avenue to leave the area or make an immediate left turn onto Canning Avenue to follow the marked-out U-Turn set up. This will enable drivers to safely turn around and park at the designated parking located at 4300 Haddonfield Road (The Bayada Office Building).

Anyone parking in a business lot (Other than Bayada), and is not approved to do so, is subject to being towed at the business owner/operator's discretion. Anyone who is found to have their vehicle towed by a business is subject to paying fees with the towing company.

ONSITE PARKING

ONLY vehicles with the proper parking credentials will be permitted to park in the Swim Club lot.

Offsite parking is ample

Pennsauken Police will be assisting us with traffic flow and have the streets lined and monitored in front of the swim club. PLEASE REFER TO THE PENNSAUKEN PD Traffic Plan above.

- Illegally parked vehicles will be moved at the discretion of Pennsauken PD.

OFF-SITE PARKING

There will be an off site lot 0.8 miles from the Swim Club at BAYADA HOME HEALTH CARE. This is located at the corner of Haddonfield Road and Maple Avenue.

Shuttle service will be provided on a continuous basis throughout the duration of the event.

Handicapped Parking

Handicapped parking will be available on a limited basis. As you are aware, at these meets Parking is as competitive as the event itself and there are a limited number of spaces.

We are requesting that teams reach out for Handicapped Parking (please speak to your team families) Passes in advance of the event.

We highly advise against parking on side streets.

SWIMMER DROP OFF

All swimmers will be dropped off curbside on **Maple Ave. We will not have swimmer DROP OFF in the parking lot.** There will be signage to follow and this will help expedite the process. We ask that you relay this information to parents, to ensure a SAFE & EXPEDITED process.

PLEASE REFERENCE THE ABOVE MAP - WITH DETAILED DROP OFF INSTRUCTIONS.

All vehicles will be directed to the DROP OFF area in the front of Pinsetter's. The area will be clearly marked.

Swimmers will enter through the Main Pool entrance.

For our little swimmers and their parents that opt to accompany them into the event, Please follow General Parking and take the shuttle to the Swim Club.

All drop offs will occur DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF PINSETTERS (the NORTH side of Maple Ave). We ask, for the safety of your child, that you DO NOT LET THEM CROSS MAPLE AVENUE.

All events will take place in the Main Pool. While Woodbine has 3 pools, the main pool will host all the events. The Junior Pool will be open for Warm Up/Cool Down for athletes, but not open to spectators.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Food and Beverage

There will be a Snack Stand open to everyone throughout the event. This will be located in the Pavilion. Coaches will be allotted a Food coupon at the Seeding Meeting. Otherwise, all food and beverage will be available for purchase. (Cash, Credit, Apple Pay)

Merchandise

The merchandise order is scheduled to be delivered and prepared prior to Team Move In. We will have a designated area where Teams can pick up their team PreOrder. Merchandise will be available on both Saturday and Sunday. It will also be available online for post event orders.

Volunteers

If you are volunteering as part of the actual swimming event (Timers, Officials, etc), you are asked to report to the Clerk of Course at least 30 minutes prior to the start of your assigned time. PLEASE NOTE- This Information was sent from Tri-County.

All other volunteers please report to your area approximately 15 minutes prior to your assigned time. (PLEASE BE MINDFUL OF THE PARKING/SHUTTLE)

SEATING

Spectator Seating

Please see the Seat Saving Policy (attached) that we will be enforcing at the event. We want to be as mindful and respectful as possible to all spectators. This is a fun and exciting environment for everyone and our goal is to ensure that families have an equal opportunity to see their children swim.

Bleacher seating will be on a first come, first serve basis. The bleachers will be on the perimeter of the pool and we ask that spectators respect the marked areas. These will also be manned by volunteers.

Seat Saving Policy

Purpose

To ensure a fair and enjoyable experience for all spectators, the Tri County Swimming Championship has established the following Seat Saving Policy. This policy is designed to provide clear guidelines on saving seats and to prevent conflicts among attendees.

Policy Guidelines

1. General Seating Rules:

- **All seating at the event is on a first-come, first-served basis.**
- **No seats may be saved before the official opening time of the seating area (e.g., coaches savings seats for team families)**
- **Personal items used to save seats (e.g., blankets, towels, bags) will be removed by event staff if left unattended for more than 30 minutes.**

2. Saving Seats for Others:

- **Each attendee is allowed to save a maximum of two seats for others.**
- **Saved seats must be occupied within 30 minutes of the saver's arrival.**
- **Unattended items in violation of this policy will be collected and held at the lost and found.**

3. Reserved Seating Areas:

- **Certain areas may be designated as reserved seating for officials, VIPs, and special guests. These areas will be clearly marked and are not available for general seating or saving.**
- **Access to reserved seating areas requires proper identification or tickets.**

4. Family and Group Seating:

- **Families and groups are encouraged to arrive together to secure adjacent seating.**
- **Saving large blocks of seats for late-arriving group members is not permitted.**
- **During team events, we encourage you to sit as close together as possible for maximum enjoyment. We ask that you vacate so other teams may enjoy the same courtesy.**

5. Handling Conflicts:

- **In the event of a dispute over saved seats, attendees are encouraged to seek assistance from event staff.**
- **Event staff have the authority to enforce the Seat Saving Policy and make final decisions on seating disputes.**

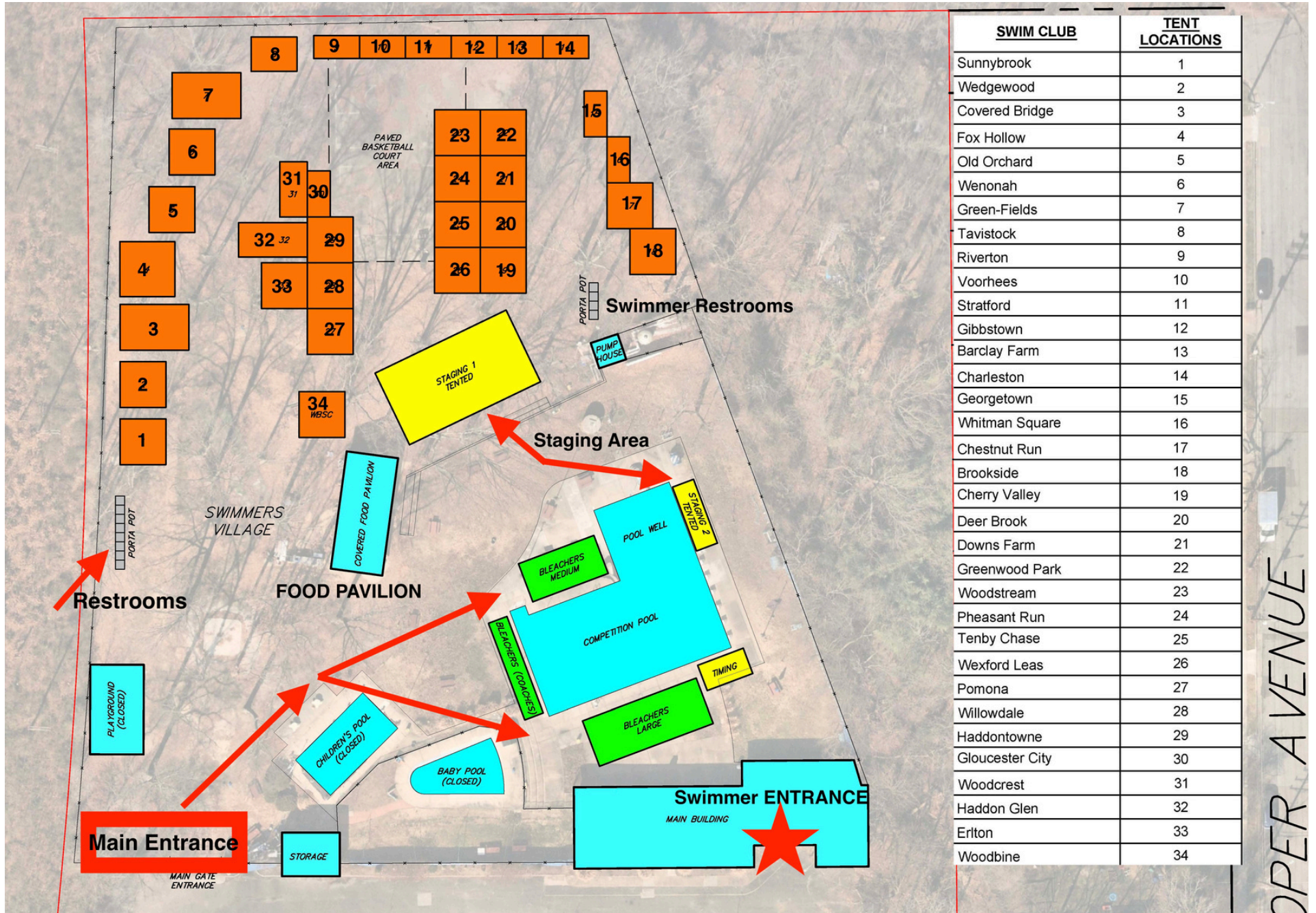
6. Accessibility Seating:

- **Designated seating for individuals with disabilities and their companions is available. These seats are not to be saved or occupied by others.**

7. Compliance and Enforcement:

- **Non-compliance with the Seat Saving Policy may result in the removal of personal items and the forfeiture of saved seats.**
- **Repeated violations may result in removal from the event without a refund.**
